"Simon Roberts: Public Performance" is an exhibition of largeformat tableaux from the photographer's recent body of work Sight

Roberts frames popular tourist viewing platforms within grand
Swiss landscapes - a managed point of view which simultaneously
implicates the viewer and photographed spectators in a performance
of looking.

field that effectively flattens the image plane. The dense congregation of humans constrained to the designated viewing arena in *Mount Pilatus*, *Lucerne*, *Switzerland* suggests an experience of natural wonder that is as mechanical and collective as the means by which it is memorialized. His is a cinematic hyper-realism which quietly points to the absurd.
